Fire Safety Policy & Procedures
Patient Room Fire Safety Advice

For your safety, protection and comfort Huddersfield Hospital building have been constructed to meeting standards of fire safety and are equipped with an automatic fire detection system covering all areas of the hospital.

Fire Safety Instructions

In the unlikely event of a fire occurring in the hospital, if patients are in danger they will be evacuated to the nearest safe protected area by nursing staff. Visitors will be asked to evacuate immediately so as to ensure that if any subsequent evacuation of patients and staff becomes necessary it can be undertaken as quickly as possible.

The fire alarm is a continual alarm.

If you hear the alarm you should remain in your room and you will receive instructions and help from a member of staff. Your visitors however, should leave by the clearly signed fire exit route or as directed by a member of staff and go to the hospital assembly point.

Note: The fire alarm is tested weekly and you will be informed prior to the test.

During the test please remain in your room as the fire doors across the corridors will close automatically and other quiet.

The duration of the test will be between 5-10 seconds.

If you discover a fire in your room and if you are able to do so leave the room, close the door and raise the alarm by either pulling a member of staff or by operating the nearest fire alarm call point.

If you are not able to leave the room, raise the alarm immediately by using the nurse call facility and staff will come to your assistance.

Do not return to your room even to collect personal belongings unless you have been told it is safe to do so.
